Prayer for the Day by Revd Canon David White

I asked for health, that I might do greater things;
I was given infirmity that I might do better things...
I asked for riches, that I might be happy,
I was given poverty, that I might be wise...
I asked for power, that I might have the praise of all people,
I was given weakness, that I might feel the need of God...
I asked for all things, that I might enjoy life,
I was given life that I might enjoy all things...
I got nothing I asked for.
Almost despite myself, my unspoken prayers were answered.
I am among all people, most richly blessed. Amen.

This anonymous prayer does not address God directly, or Jesus, or the Holy Spirit. It is thought to have been written by an American soldier during the American Civil War – but there is no certainty about that. It seems to be more of a reflection of a person's experience of praying to which God is invited to listen in. It recounts that person's experience of asking God for things that he or she would like to have in order to improve their life, but what they actually receive is something else, something much less – or even the opposite.

It is a prayer that has a universal application as many must feel this way at some time in life. It offers the insight that the value of prayer and praying lies as much in what we don't say as what we do. As we commemorate the 80th Anniversary of V E Day this week, we remember all whose prayers during those wartime years had seemed not to be answered in the way they wanted but who, in time, still found themselves 'most richly blessed'. This is still relevant for us today, as well.
