Prayer for the Day

God of Love, show us our place in this world as channels of your love for all the creatures of this earth, for not one of them is forgotten in your sight. Enlighten those who possess power and money that they may avoid the sin of indifference, that they may love the common good, advance the weak, and care for this world in which we live. The poor and the earth are crying out. O Lord, seize us with your power and light, help us to protect all life to prepare for a better future, for the coming of your Kingdom of justice, love and beauty. Praise be to you! Amen.

This is part of a prayer of Pope Francis, who died earlier this year, and is from his important pastoral letter (or encyclical) on the care of the earth entitled "Laudato Si. On Care for Our Common Home"; published in 2015. Laudato si is Latin for "Praise be to You". The prayer asks God, the creator of all, to help us care for the earth and that he may especially influence those who have economic influence and power. Throughout the Bible it is shown that God has a special care and concern for the poor and disadvantaged. Invariably, these are the ones who are most affected by climate change and the impact of environmental disasters. In this country, we are now into our third heat wave this year and recent flash flooding in Texas has taken the lives of over a hundred people. The increased frequency of such events across the world shows that humanity must change its ways and prayer has a vital role in this.
